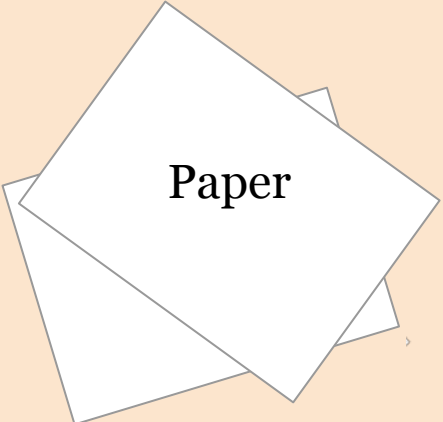

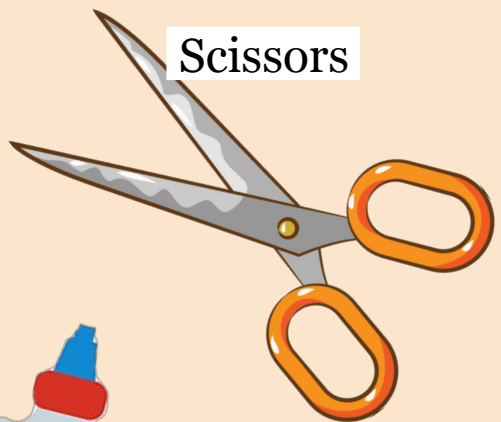

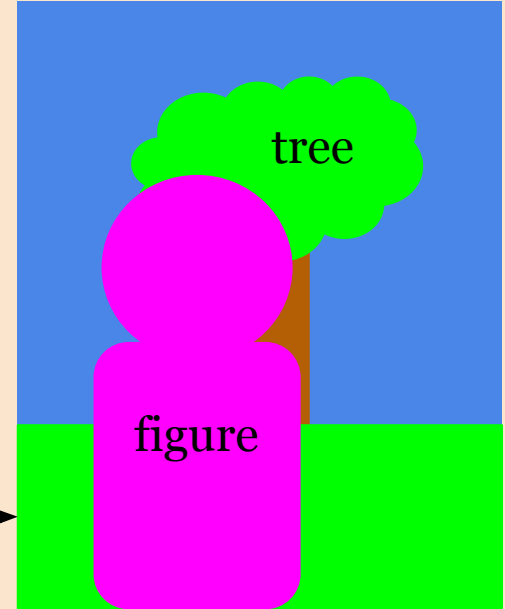

Requirements:

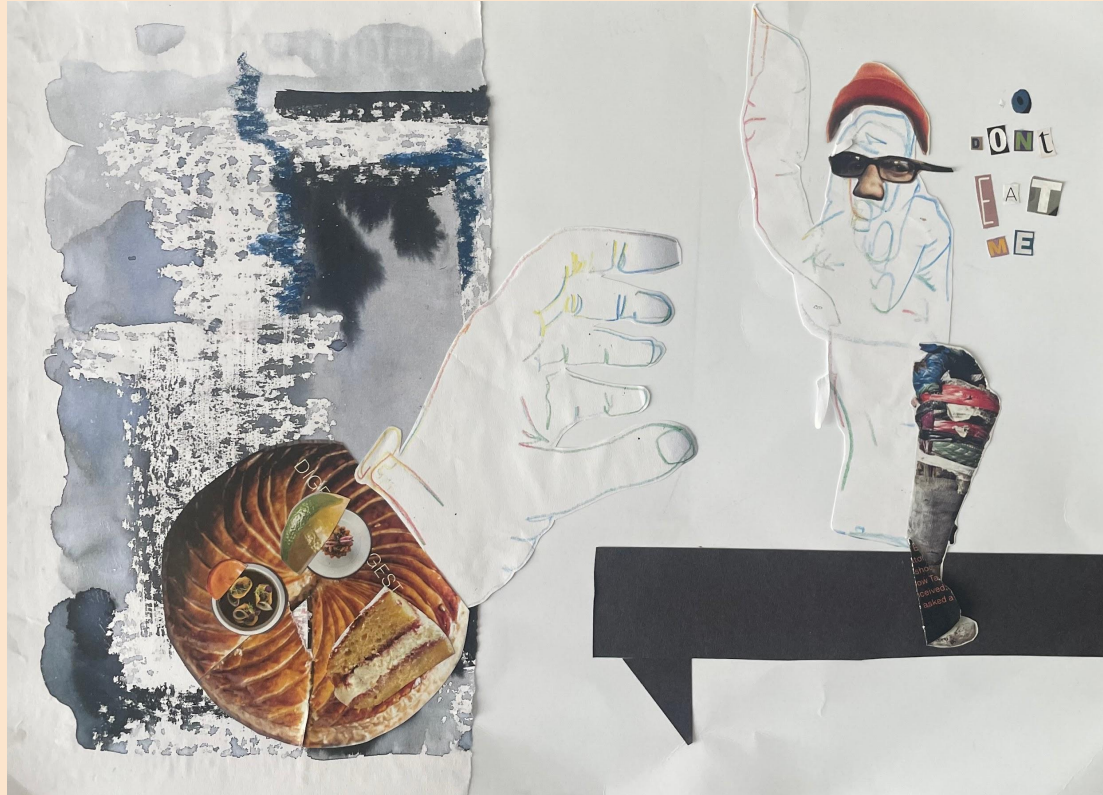
- Base your collage on the theme
